RESORT CHARGE

With Resort Charge, you can attach a credit card to your Season Pass or PEAKS Card and use it to charge at designated Vail Resorts' on-mountain restaurants and retail locations (not available at Arapahoe Basin Food and Beverage). If you choose to take advantage of Resort Charge, you will also have the option to sign-up for Direct-To-Lift access. Direct-To-Lift privileges enable you to bypass the ticket window and go direct to the lift at our resorts through an automatic charge to your credit card. When you present your Season Pass or PEAKS Card, your credit card will be charged the daily lift ticket price determined by the time you access the mountain – full day (9am), afternoon (noon) or the late afternoon rate (2pm). Use the Direct-To-Lift feature when your season pass is restricted or at locations where it is not valid. If you choose to enable Direct-To-Lift privileges, please be aware of restricted dates associated with your pass.

Resort Charge Agreement

I hereby authorize a Vail Resorts affiliate company to charge my credit card each time my season pass is presented for charging privileges at participating Vail Resorts' establishments. I understand that some restrictions may apply. I understand that I will be responsible for all charges made using my season pass and that I am responsible for securing my pass. Coverage applies for season passes, including the Epic 7-Pack and Keystone 4-Pack, valid for the 2010/11 season, October 15, 2010 through May 15, 2011. Refunds will not be provided beyond May 15, 2011 because all refunds are pro-rated based on the number of days skied by the date an incident occurs (10/15 – 5/15). For example, if you make a claim in January after using your pass three times previously, your refund amount will take three days of prior pass use into account.

*Note: Pass Insurance is not transferable or refundable. All refunds are pro-rated based on the number of days skied by the date an incident occurs. Pre-existing conditions may not qualify. Pass refunds are available only where a guest purchased pass insurance and has a valid claim under the insurance policy.

WARNING, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY. THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND WAIVER OF CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS.

The person for whom this season pass is purchased shall be referred to hereinafter as "Holder". The "Undersigned" means only the Holder when the Holder is age 18 or older OR it means both the Holder and the Holder's parent or legal guardian when the Holder is under the age of 18. **The Undersigned agree and understand that skiing, snowboarding and using ski area facilities, including the lifts, for any purpose (hereinafter the "Activity"), can be HAZARDOUS AND INVOLVES THE RISK OF PHYSICAL INJURY AND/OR DEATH.**

The Undersigned expressly **ASSUME ALL RISKS** associated with Holder's participation in the Activity, known or unknown, inherent or otherwise, the Undersigned agree and understand these risks include, but are not limited to: falling, slick or uneven surfaces, surface and subsurface snow conditions; bumps, moguls, ice, variations in terrain, rugged mountainous terrain, downed timber, stumps, forest growth, rocks, debris, marked and unmarked obstacles, visibility, collisions, encounters with snowmobiles and/or other motor vehicles, lift loading, unloading, and riding, adverse weather, limited access to and/or delay of medical attention, fatigue, exhaustion, dehydration, hypothermia, high elevation, altitude sickness, frostbite, & mental distress from exposure to any of the above.

Holder assumes the responsibility of maintaining control at all times while engaging in the Activity. Holder is responsible for reading, understanding and complying with all signage, including instructions on use of lifts. Holder must have the physical dexterity and knowledge to safely load, ride and unload the lifts. Further, the Undersigned understand that a minor Holder may use the ski lifts without an adult present. The Undersigned are advised that snowmobiles, snowmaking, and snow-grooming equipment may be encountered at any time.

RECOGNIZING THE RISKS AND DANGERS, THE UNDERSIGNED UNDERSTAND THE NATURE OF THE ACTIVITY AND VOLUNTARILY CHOOSE FOR HOLDER TO PARTICIPATE IN AND EXPRESSLY ASSUME ALL RISKS AND DANGERS OF THE ACTIVITY, WHETHER OR NOT DESCRIBED ABOVE, KNOWN OR UNKNOWN, INHERENT OR OTHERWISE.

In consideration for allowing the Holder to participate in the Activity, **THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY AGREE NOT TO SUE** Vail Resorts, Inc., The Vail Corporation, it's affiliated companies and subsidiaries, including but not limited to those that operate the Vail, Beaver Creek, Keystone, and Breckenridge resorts, Heavenly Valley Limited Partnership d/b/a Heavenly Mountain Resort, its General Partner VR Heavenly I, Inc., Trimont Land Company d/b/a Northstar-at-Tahoe, Dundee Realty USA, LLC d/b/a Arapahoe Basin Ski Area, the U.S. Forest Service, and all their respective insurance companies, successors in interest, agents, employees, representatives, assignees, officers, directors, and shareholders (each hereinafter a "Released Party") for any property damage (including but not limited to equipment damage), injury or loss to Holder, including death, which Holder may suffer, arising in whole or in part out of Holder's participation in the Activity. By agreeing not to sue, the Undersigned are releasing any right to make a claim or file a lawsuit against any Released Party. Also, the **UNDERSIGNED AGREE TO HOLD HARMLESS AND RELEASE EACH AND EVERY RELEASED PARTY FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY** and/or claims for injury or death to persons or damage to property arising from Holder's participation in the Activity, including, but not limited to, those claims based on any Released Party's alleged or actual **NEGLIGENCE or BREACH of any CONTRACT and/or express or implied WARRANTY**. By execution of this Agreement, the Undersigned also **AGREE TO DEFEND AND INDEMNIFY/REIMBURSE** each Released Party from any and all claims of the Undersigned and/or a third party arising in whole or in part from Holder's participation in the Activity.

The ski area operator shall have the right to confiscate or revoke the privileges conferred by the pass where, in the sole judgment of the Ski Area's representative, the Holder: 1) acts in any manner that endangers or may endanger the safety of Holder or any other person; 2) violates the law; 3) provides ski lessons or related services for compensation without express authorization; or 4) engages in misconduct or creates a nuisance.

In consideration of allowing Holder to use the ski area facilities, **THE UNDERSIGNED CONTRACTUALLY AGREE THAT ANY AND ALL CLAIMS** for injury and/or death regarding an alleged incident **SHALL BE GOVERNED BY COLORADO LAW** (for Vail, Beaver Creek, Breckenridge, Keystone, Arapahoe Basin) **OR CALIFORNIA LAW** (for Heavenly and Northstar-at-Tahoe), and **EXCLUSIVE JURISDICTION** shall be in the state or federal court sitting in the district where the alleged incident occurred.

In the case of a minor Holder, the Undersigned parent or legal guardian acknowledges that he/she is signing on behalf of the minor and that the minor shall be bound by all the terms of this Agreement. By signing this Agreement without a parent or legal guardian's signature, Holder, under penalty of fraud, represents that he/she is at least 18 years of age. If signing as the parent or guardian of a minor Holder, signing adults represent that they are a **legal** parent or guardian of the minor Holder. The Undersigned understand and acknowledge that this Agreement is a contract and shall be binding to the fullest extent permitted by law. If any part of this Agreement is deemed to be unenforceable, the remaining terms shall be an enforceable contract between the parties. It is the Undersigned's intent that this Agreement shall be binding upon the assignees, subrogors, distributors, heirs, next of kin, executors and personal representatives of the Undersigned.

THE UNDERSIGNED REPRESENTS THAT HE OR SHE IS THE PASS APPLICANT OR LEGAL PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF THE PASS APPLICANT. THE UNDERSIGNED AGREES TO INDEMNIFY THE RELEASED PARTIES FOR ALL LIABILITY AND CLAIMS, INCLUDING ATTORNEYS FEES, ARISING FROM ANY MISREPRESENTATIONS MADE IN THIS APPLICATION OR FRAUDULENT EXECUTION OF THIS AGREEMENT.
